Clinic flow:

Taylor will call a competitor and watch them as they go through the pattern. Following their ride, Taylor will explain what was good and what could be improved and how to make those improvements. Each competitor will then go through the pattern in front of Taylor one more time before the next competitor is called.

While waiting for their group to be called, competitors are encouraged to ride through the trail patterns set up on the fairgrounds.
